This charming Christmas hymn by Max Reger, reminiscent of a lullaby, can be performed by a soloist or unison voices, making it a flexible and accessible addition to any Christmas program. The original German text is illuminated by William J. Bullock's prosodic English translation.

FROM THE TRANSLATOR:

This forthright song is by a celebrated German composer whose artistic worth far surpasses his generally meager representation on the concert stage. The last song in his cycle Twelve Sacred Songs, Op. 37, was composed in1914, late in the composer's life. Strophic in form, the song hints at its composer's mastery of chromatic harmony, but reveals no trace of the polyphonic ingenuity Reger displayed in his earlier works, at times in excess.
