FROM THE COMPOSER:

I first discovered this charming short poem by Robert Browning when I was in my mid to late teenage years. I initially chose to set the poem because I thought it would suit a male/lower voice choir. Robert and his wife Elizabeth Barrett Browning, a successful poet in her own right, wrote each other many poems and love letters, which led me to imagine that this back-and-forth could be done in a choral setting with each group presenting a song to the other. I enjoyed how the poet brings depth to the simple act of a kiss – in this brief, intimate moment, he hits at sweet tastes and fragrances, rich colors, and wonderful mysteries. I brought these images to life with a lyrical, expressive musical setting. Above all, Browning celebrates the sincerity and trust of an innocent expression of love.
