ABOUT:

This thoughtful art song tells the story of the Magi with lush harmonies and a lyrical melody, further illuminated by an expressive new English translation.

FROM THE COMPOSER:

The conditions of the visit and gift-giving of the three Wise Men are portrayed in this sensitive art song. Composed by one of the greatest French song writers, it tells the familiar story in two verses. The first verse sets the first of two poetic quatrains; the second verse sets the second two quatrains. The song concludes with a coda (the final quatrain), which relates the story to society today.

Typically, the piano accompaniment varies verse to verse to better express the text. Atypically, the song is supported by an organ (harmonium) or synthesizer. The translation maintains the prosody and rhyme scheme of the original French.
